SUICIDE AWARENESS & PREVENTION



September is Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. According to the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (2022), suicide is the third leading cause of death for people ages 10-19. North East High School's football program experienced this first hand on July 28, 2019, when one of their players, Thomas Ocasio III, died by suicide at the age of 16.

The LIVEFORTHOMAS Foundation was founded in 2020 by Thomas's mom, Amy, and his sister, Michaela. Their mission is to break the stigma, change the face of suicide (it can happen to anyone), and change the narrative men are "weak" if they show emotion/ask for help.

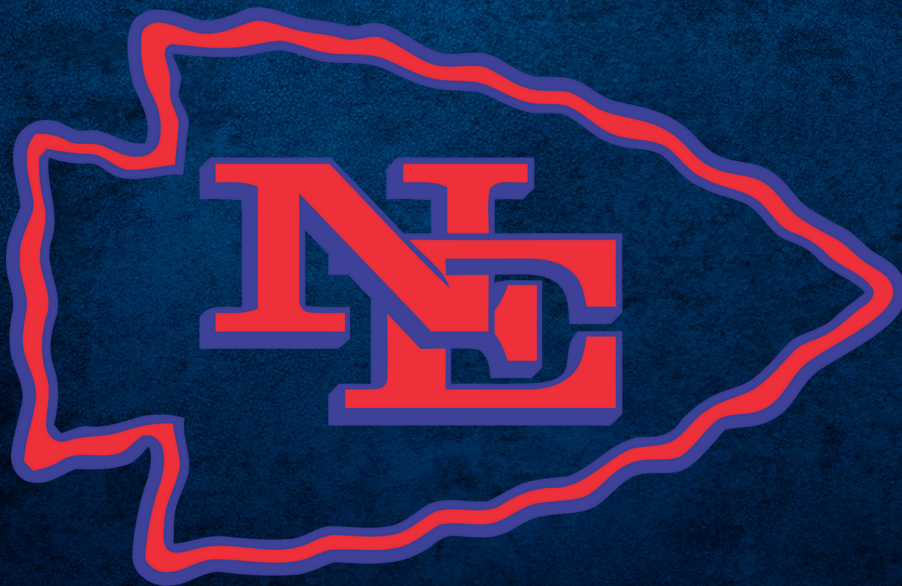

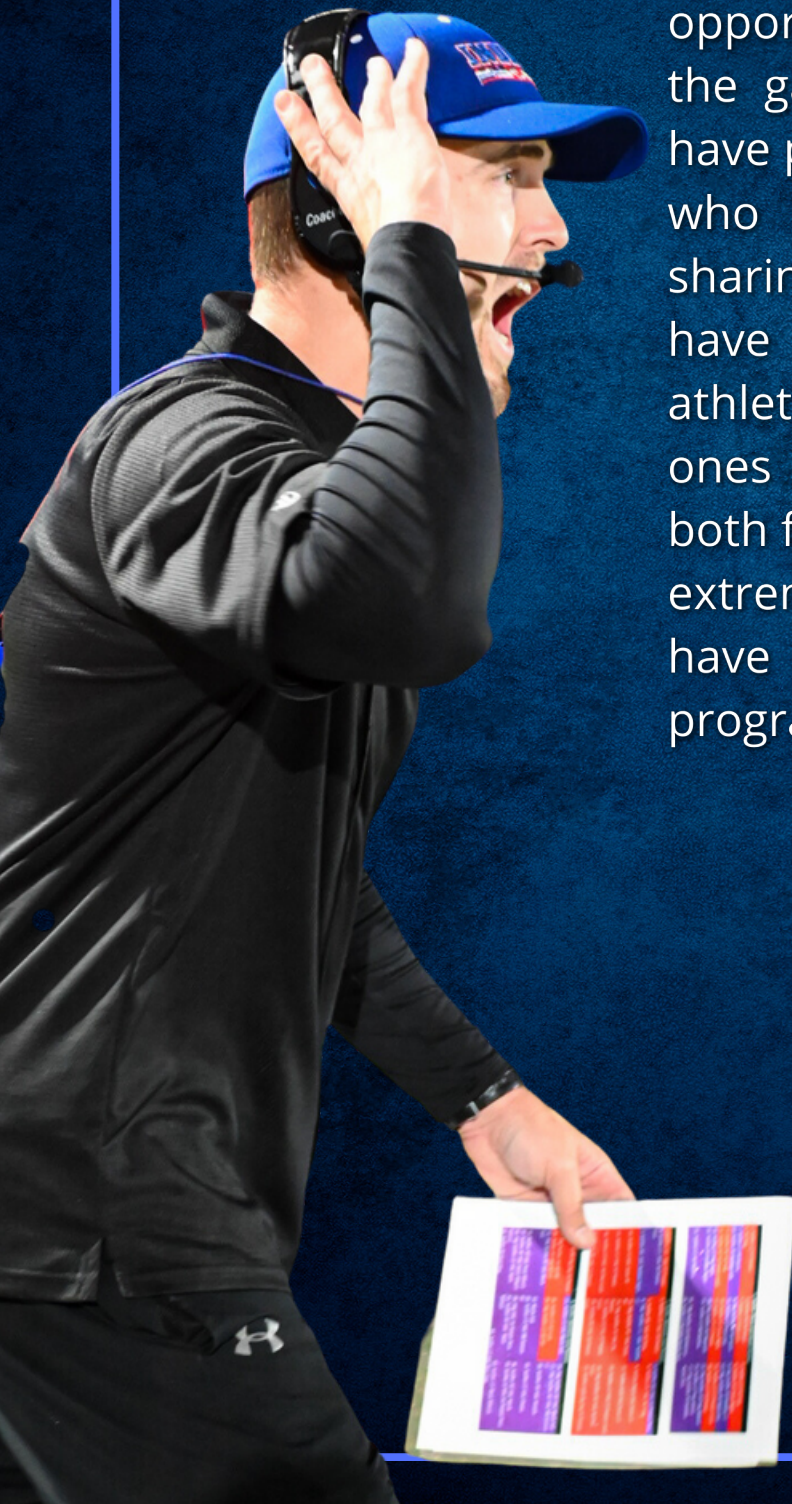

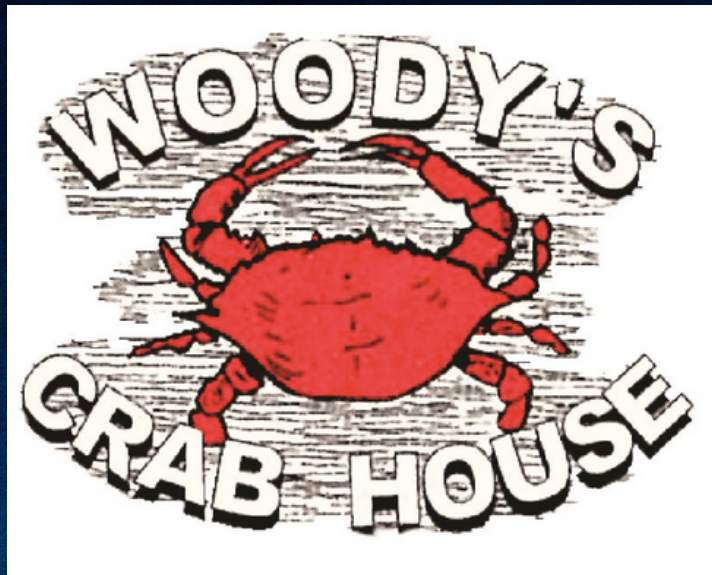
